## **What is a Special Use of Parking Permit and why do I need one?**

If a business owners or company is loading in/out of a Main Street venue, required to provide crowd control, park a satellite truck, store a POD or require a lift/boom or if you are looking for preform an activity that requires the use of Public Parking spaces. Call 435.615.5301 to obtain a Special Use of Public Parking Permit. Permits deadline is 72 hours in advance of any load in or load out.

**Please do not block traffic. Be aware of pedestrians when you are dropping off or picking up. Be mindful of all posted signs and of other traffic or sight impediments that may be caused for drivers and pedestrians when you are pulling over.**

**In order, to pull over in drop and load areas, the driver must remain in the vehicle and must be actively dropping off or loading in passengers.**

**Please be respectful when driving through residential areas—mind the speed limit and posted signs and watch for pedestrians and children in the area.**

**Remember, help reduce Park City's carbon footprint—Take Transit, Walk or Bike and Carpool. If driving, please remember—Turn your Key and Be Idle Free!**

We continue to encourage locals and visitors alike to use alternative parking areas outside of the Old Town core with transit to help ease traffic and congestion. Additionally, the City has worked to establish a Taxi, Hotel Shuttle, Ride Share drop and pick up area on Swede Alley. The best way for Taxi, Hotel Shuttles and Ride Share companies to access the Main Street area is to enter off of Deer Valley Drive and turn onto Swede Alley.

### **RICHARDSON FLATS PARK AND RIDE**

Richardson Flats Parking Lot will be available with transit to and from to the High School from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m. January 20 — 23. From the high school you can transfer on transit or walk to venues in Prospect. On January 19 and January 24 — 29, this lot will be available for carpool parking only with no transit service. Parking in this lot is free throughout the festival.
